

1. Call McCoy to arrange for washing, digging up the grave, and burial
2. Digging up the grave:
 - a. Someone should go and open the gate and meet the guy who will dig up the grave
 - b. Depth: about 4ft
 - c. Width: about 4-5ft (depending on the height of the deceased.)
 - d. Length: about 6-8 ft (depending on the height of the deceased.)
 - e. Add about one ft for the width and length for the blocks that go around the body
 - f. There is enough blocks in the grave yard
 - g. You need two layers of blocks
3. Piece(s) of wood (ply wood or OSB)
 - a. Length: about 6-6.5 ft (depending on the height of the deceased.)
 - b. Width: 2-3 ft (depending on the height of the deceased.)
4. Washing:
 - a. Buy towels:
 - i. Small: to clean/massage the body
 - ii. Large: to cover the private parts
 - iii. Medium to dry afterwards
 - b. Gloves (usually provided by McCoy)
 - c. Bucket for water (usually provided by McCoy)
 - d. Sidr (could use body shampoo instead)
 - e. Kafoor
 - f. Oil/Teeb/Musk
5. Shrouding
 - a. From JoAnn you can buy white sheets "Muslin"
 - b. The width should be 90" or 108"
 - c. Each piece should be about 8'
 - d. Make some piece to tie up the shroud.
6. McCoy should arrange for the transportation from their place to the Masjid and to the grave yard.
7. Burial:
 - a. Bring water to mix with dirt and to wash hands
 - b. Shovels
